



MARKETS MAKES SHOPPING EASIER FOR CHRISTMAS SHOPPERS

With increased traffic flow anticipated for Christmas trading, particularly at the Sydney Fresh Food Market on Saturdays at Flemington, Sydney Markets have joined forces with the Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) and NSW Police to ensure more easy and convenient access to and from the markets.

“With thousands of parking spaces available, this will ensure that shoppers will be able to enter and exit the site with minimum delay, especially for that last minute food shopping on Christmas Eve and New Year’s Eve”,

The changed traffic conditions will commence Saturday, **December 16th** and continue each Saturday including Saturday **December 23rd** and **December 31st**. During the Christmas shopping period motorists should use the following routes:

- Market customers traveling eastbound on the M4 Motorway should take the Silverwater Road exit, then use Parramatta Road to enter Sydney Markets via Austin Avenue entrance;
- Market customers traveling westbound on Parramatta Road should use the Potts Street entrance;
- Market customers traveling southbound on Homebush Bay Drive should use Kerruish Avenue entrance;
- Market customers traveling northbound on Centenary Drive should use Potts Street entrance via Parramatta Road

The loop road from Marlborough Road, under Centenary Drive will may be temporarily closed, subject to traffic conditions. Access to Sydney Markets will be available via Parramatta Road and Potts Street.
